The clip has to focus on the topic given in the contest description. One hard copy of the application has to be sent to the address mentioned above.
3. Submitted material will not be returned.
4. Application forms have to be submitted in English. Video clips can be in national languages.
5. The winners will be selected by STOP MALARIA NOW! until the 14th of July 2010. The decision will be final. Successful applicants will be contacted in time.
6. No entry fees are due for submitting films.

STOP MALARIA NOW! is responsible for organisation and covers all costs for travel to and from Kenya as well as local transportation required for the shooting, accommodation and meals for the duration of the shooting. Selected participants are responsible to cover private expenses and visa fees. The Participant is also responsible to care for his/her medical check-up, vaccinations and malaria prophylaxis.
